The requirement for graduation from Fairfield Community High school varies depending on the year of graduation. Of the total credits, sixteen or more must be in academic subjects and four must be in physical education, driver education and health.

According to the Illinois State Board of Higher Education, all students who plan to enter a college or university must have completed, in high school, four years of English, three years of social studies, three years of natural sciences which include labs, three years of math beginning with Algebra I, and a combination of two years of vocational classes, foreign language, art and/or music. Although these classes are not required for graduation from FCHS, they are required of students who wish to enter college.
